

CAR ACCIDENT 101 CHECKLIST



Get to Safety / Call the Police

Move your vehicle to a safe spot if you can and check for injuries. Call 911, stay at the scene, and do not admit fault or speculate about what happened.



Exchange Information

Get the names, contact information, license plate numbers, vehicle details, and insurance information of everyone involved. Also, collect witness information and the responding officer's badge number and report number.



Document the Scene / Preserve Evidence

Take photos and videos of the vehicles, damage, road conditions, traffic signs, and any injuries. Write down the time, location, weather, and your memory of what happened as soon as possible.



Seek Medical Attention

See a doctor right away, even if you feel okay. Some injuries take time to appear, so follow all treatment instructions and keep your records, bills, and prescriptions.



Notify Your Insurance Company

Tell your insurance company about the accident as soon as possible. Stick to the basic facts, and do not give a recorded statement before speaking with a lawyer.
